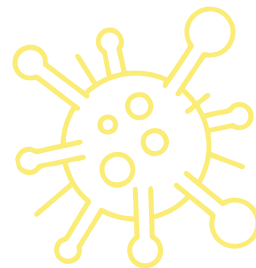
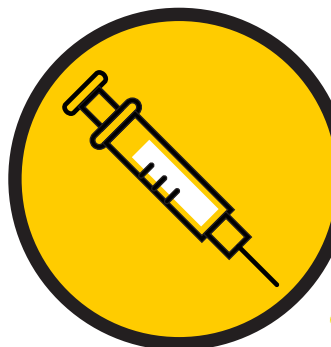


STAYING COVID-19 SAFE ADVICE FOR KIDNEY PATIENTS
