

# Sustainable Kidney Care Committee

### Welcome & introductions - Declarations of interest

SK welcomed members. The only new declaration made was from SK – AstraZeneca have funded development of Newcastle's in-centre HD carbon calculator.

#### **Committee membership**

SK highlighted some changes to committee membership. Rona Hutton has stepped down as committee co-chair and nursing representative – SK led the committee in thanking Rona for her work for the committee and wished her the best for the future. SK also offered congratulations to Katie Vinen on becoming UKKA President-elect and who will thus step back from a supportive role within the committee – SK thanked Katie for her valuable advice and input to the group.

SK noted the above means <u>there is a vacancy for MPT co-chair of the committee</u>. If any committee members are interested in taking up the role, they are welcome to informally discuss this with SK. There is also a <u>vacancy in the committee for a nursing representative</u>; SK has submitted a call for EoIs to KJ for distribution to the ANN UK membership.

#### **Matters arising**

The committee agreed that the minutes of the March meeting were accurate. The only matter arising was to note a submission for an oral presentation, describing the programme's work, to the UKHACC – BMJ Net Zero Clinical Care conference (14<sup>th</sup> July 2023; decision expected this month).

SK used Gannt chart to update on progress for different areas of committee work:

- **Top tips document:** now top dozen tips. Almost complete, CF adding branding and will circulate final version to group for 24-hour turn-around before dissemination aiming for publication on 19<sup>th</sup> May. SK thanked the group for their input/feedback on the document. SK discussed comms strategy, including, UKKA social media, UKKW Climate Clinic, Networks forum, CD forum (awaiting response), and culminating in UKKA SKC webinar on 18<sup>th</sup> October; SK has asked if specialty group representatives could please send out to their respective UKKA professional groups. Distribution, also, to KCUK and the NKF patient organisations and via SHC, CSH.
- **RSTP:** release delayed until June from end of March, awaiting sign off for toolkits. Other dashboard/engagement packs circulating presently which are light on sustainability information.
- Metrics: MW/SK discussed with Smeeta Sinha, National Clinical Director for Renal. UKRR and NHSE not keen on manual uploads of data and currently all metrics would have to be manually collected. MW is planning to trial data collection to look at feasibility in NE/Humber/Yorks area with interested units for 12 months, launch meeting scheduled for 23<sup>rd</sup> May.





- Industry liaison group, generic Joint Statement of Demand: this is likely to be via the ISN's GREEN-K programme one proposed route to involve industry outreach ("a global ask is being developed get involved") -> one or more workshops with relevant service-side reps to define detail of generic JSoD in terms of net zero, circularity, social value, resilience, affordability, access -> industry briefing event, Autumn 2023 -> industry engagement on generic JSoD before finalisation and release by end 2023
- **WS2 resourcing**: SK is to put together a bid to support engagement work and to develop product specific JSoDs (completion by end 2024)
- Unit champions: only 3 units have signed up so far (Royal Berkshire, Newcastle & Coventry/Warwickshire). Will use UKKW as opportunity to sign people up, and the webinar in October. The group agreed to aim for 90% of hub units signed up by October end. AT and DW have discussed with colleagues but found reluctance as they are unsure what the role involves will re-circulate the materials about the role although SK noted that the level of involvement could include simply acting as a point of contact. FM highlighted the need for the information to have an online home, which could be the network and then link to the SKC page on the UKKA site. MH suggested having a map of the UK showing which units were engaging proactively with sustainability SK thought this would be a good idea and suggested adding to the agenda to discuss at the next meeting
- Action: Re-circulate materials on unit sustainability champions
- Action: Add sustainability map to agenda for next meeting
- **Climate Clinic at UKKW:** EM updated on planning progress for the session time and date now confirmed, planning to focus on unit champion sign ups, top tips document and helping with individual issues/solutions. SK flagged that the session does not appear on the current iteration of the UKKW programme this will be added in the next iteration.
- **SKC webinar:** SA updated: group scholars have agreed to attend and present work, and MH/MW also will provide some pre-recorded information.
- UK Health Alliance on Climate Change: still hoping to sign up to this to allow crossdisciplinary learning.
- Life RESYSTAL: SK suggested committee members could make informal EOIs to be involved in this if desired. SK will set up meeting with Healthcare without Harm team after presenting the project at the September committee meeting; hoping, at this point, to have committee backing to pursue UKKA sign off on membership agreement.
- Action: SK to present summary of LIFE RESYTAL at September meeting
- Newcastle whole service LCA, carbon calculator development: resource streams still to be confirmed but SK will keep the committee updated.
- Holborn declaration: MH met with UKKA re: 2024 conference, want to be marker for other conferences re: sustainability and UKKA keen to do this.
